In order for your ballot to count, you must return a photocopy of your ID no later than **November 11, 2020**. If your ID lists an address, it must be a Colorado address.

1. Select an appropriate identification

Acceptable Forms of Identification

- A valid Colorado driver's license except one issued to an individual that is not a citizen of the United States;
- A valid identification card by the Department of Revenue;
- A valid employee identification card with a photograph of the eligible elector issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the United States government or of this state, or by any county, municipality, board, authority, or other political subdivision of this state;
- A valid pilot's license issued by the Federal Aviation Administration or other authorized agency of the United States;
- A valid United States military identification card with a photograph of the eligible elector;
- A copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows the name and address of the elector;
- A valid Medicare or Medicaid card issued by the United States Health Care Financing Administration;
- A certified copy of a birth certificate for the elector issued in the United States;
- Certified documentation of naturalization;
- A valid student identification card with a photograph of the eligible elector issued by an institution of higher education in Colorado;
- A valid veteran identification card with a photograph of the eligible elector issued by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs Veterans Health Administration;
- A valid identification card issued by a federally recognized tribal government certifying tribal membership;
- Written verification that you are a resident of a group residential facility, are committed to the Department of Human Services, or are in the custody of the Department of Youth Corrections;
- A valid United States passport.
- Written correspondence from the county sheriff or his or her designee to the county clerk indicating you are confined in a county jail or detention facility.

2. Make a photocopy of that identification

If your identification shows an address, it must be a Colorado address.

3. Return the copy of identification

Return the copy of your ID to the Clerk and Recorder's Office by **November 11, 2020**. You may return it by:

We have received your provisional ballot for the **November 3, 2020 General** Election. You were required to vote by provisional ballot because you did not present an acceptable form of identification at the polling location as required by Colorado election law.

In order for your provisional ballot to count, you must provide a copy of one of the following acceptable forms of identification to our office no later than **November 11, 2020**.

Acceptable Forms of Identification

- A valid Colorado driver's license, except one issued to an individual that is not a citizen of the United States;
- A valid identification card by the Department of Revenue;
- A valid employee identification card with a photograph of the eligible elector issued by any branch, department, agency, or entity of the United States government or of this state, or by any county, municipality, board, authority, or other political subdivision of this state;
- A valid pilot's license issued by the Federal Aviation Administration or other authorized agency of the United States;
- A valid United States military identification card with a photograph of the eligible elector;
- A copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows the name and address of the elector;
- A valid Medicare or Medicaid card issued by the United States Health Care Financing Administration;
- A certified copy of a birth certificate for the elector issued in the United States;
- Certified documentation of naturalization;
- A valid student identification card with a photograph of the eligible elector issued by an institution of higher education in Colorado;
- A valid veteran identification card with a photograph of the eligible elector issued by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs Veterans Health Administration;
- A valid identification card issued by a federally recognized tribal government certifying tribal membership;
- Written verification that you are a resident of a group residential facility, are committed to the Department of Human Services, or are in the custody of the Department of Youth Corrections;
- A valid United States passport.
- Written correspondence from the county sheriff or his or her designee to the county clerk indicating you are confined in a county jail or detention facility.

If your ID lists an address, it must be a Colorado address. You can return a photocopy of an acceptable form of identification by mail, fax, or email to:
