Re: Mail Ballot Return Envelope Missing or Discrepant Signature

Dear «FIRST_NAME» «MIDDLE_NAME» «LAST_NAME» «NAME_SUFFIX»,

Jefferson County received your ballot for the November 3rd, 2020 General Election. However, we cannot count your ballot because the voter affidavit on your ballot envelope did not have a signature, or we were unable to verify your signature with those on file.

By law, we must verify the signature on your ballot envelope against the signatures in your voter registration record in order to verify your identity. Your signature did not match, and you must take action to have your ballot counted.

Please use one of the two options below to return your completed Affidavit Form, along with a copy of your ID. All completed materials must be received by 11:59 p.m. on November 12th, 2020.

Option 1: Mobile Device

1. Text *Colorado* to 28683. You will receive a single text message in reply with a secure *2vote.mobi* web link. *
2. Click the link to open the website.
3. Click the **Ballot Cure** button.
4. Type your unique PIN number: **«TRACKING_NUM»**
5. Complete the affidavit and sign with your finger.
6. *If prompted*, use the camera on your mobile device to take and submit a photo of your ID.

**Standard messaging rates apply. You will receive only one message.*

Option 2: Email, Fax, Mail, or Hand-Delivery

1. Complete and sign the Affidavit Form found here:

3. Follow the instructions on the form to provide a copy of your ID, if required.
4. Return these documents to Jefferson County in-person or by e-mail, fax or mail. *

**E-mail, fax, or mail must be received by 11:59 p.m., November 12th, 2020. Postmarks do not count.*

Note: You will also receive this letter notification by mail.

If you do not return the Affidavit Form, we will turn your ballot discrepancy over to the District Attorney's Office for investigation. Please contact our office at (303) 271-8111. We are open Monday - Thursday and then starting October 19th Monday - Friday (except legal holidays) between the hours of 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. for your convenience. Thank you for your assistance.
